S1 Humanities Course

As part of the S1 Humanities course, pupils will be experiencing the Environmental Awareness Unit from 23 April 2018. This will give opportunities for pupils to work towards and gain the first level John Muir Award – Discovery Level.

The course will cover environmental issues and look at local conservation strategies. During this time pupils will take part in local area fieldwork in and around the school, Carron Dams Local Nature Reserve and Stenhousemuir. Pupils will be under the supervision of staff and will take part in activities to gather information and conserve the local area such as species surveys, guided walks, building bug hotels and litter picking.
