S3 SNSA – Scottish National Standardised Assessments

During the week beginning Monday 21 May, all of our S3 pupils at Larbert High School will undertake an online baseline assessment, taking place during the school day.

This new system of Scottish National Standardised Assessments (SNSA) has been introduced by the Scottish Government and will focus on aspects of reading, writing and numeracy.

The assessments are completed online and results will be used to help teachers plan the next steps in learning for each child in order to help them make the best possible progress, and also highlight any areas which may require some further support or intervention.

Pupils do not have to revise or prepare for this snapshot. They are designed to be used as part of normal learning and teaching and the information they provide will be used in the same way as other assessment information, which arises from day to day classes/lessons.

The assessments are designed to be appropriate for use with all children, including those who require additional support. The assessments do not have a time limit attached to them.
